Other duties will include sharing of campground and cleaning duties, demonstrating crafts and other traditional skills, admission gate and gift store duties. Ideal candidate is creative, enthusiastic and a team player.

What is required? **Official Languages Proficiency:** English Essential. Michif, French and/or Cree would be an asset.
Education: Minimum of Grade 10 education. Standard First Aid with CPR – C is an asset.
Experience: Must be comfortable talking and interacting with people. Experience in area of cultural or heritage program delivery, and living and/or working in outdoor conditions (eg. personal recreation, outdoor recreation programs) are all assets.

What are the conditions of employment? Willingness to work in outdoor environments under a variety of weather conditions. Willingness to wear traditional Métis clothing. Medically suitable to perform duties. Some weekend work will be required.
