ABOUT THE COUNTY OF TWO HILLS

The County of Two Hills is located in the centre of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Metis Settlements, post-secondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. There are over 3,300 people residing in the County including the communities of Two Hills, Derwent, Myrnam and Willingdon. The County is strategically located with Highways 36 and 41 (High Load Corridors) running north and south, making it the perfect location as a logistics and manufacturing center. The North Saskatchewan River parallels the north border of the County, providing much of the area with valleys and rolling hills ideal for recreation and leisure.

OUR TOP INDUSTRIES



With Hwy. 45 running east /west and Hwys 36 and 41 - the High Load Corridors running north/south serving the Alberta Oil Sands - the County of Two Hills is perfect for upstream oil/gas service companies. The County's east side overlaps the Cold Lake Oil Sands area. Approx. 1500 oil/gas wells are in the County and drilling continues. With lower land costs, excellent infrastructure and an educated labour force, the County of Two Hills is an excellent choice for investment.

Agriculture

Agriculture is a major economic sector and the diversity in the region ranges from grain and specialty crops to domestic and specialty livestock. The County had over \$182 million in gross farm receipts (2021) and highly ranked in total crop acreage for wheat, barley and canola. The County of Two Hills is home to a specialized custom feedlot enterprise called Highland Feeders Ltd., which operates a 36,000 head finishing lot.



Tourism

Our rich history and scenery make tourism a growth industry in the County of Two Hills. The County is an hour away from Edmonton and the demand for vacation and recreation opportunities continues to grow. Lac Sante, a major attraction, is located in the NE part of the County. It's over 10 km long and four km wide with nine beaches, and is ideal for all water sports. Combined with numerous outdoor recreation opportunities, the area has great potential for tourism.



Transportation

Just 135 km northeast of Edmonton and the International Airport, the County has three important transportation and trucking routes: Hwy 45, an east/west corridor; and Hwy 36 and 41, two of Alberta's High Load Corridors - all of which serve the Alberta Oil Sands. The Two Hills Airport provides a non-commercial airport service with a 2,900 ft. lit runway. CN Rail access is available approx. 20 minutes south on Highway 36.
