#### ABOUT FISHING LAKE METIS SETTLEMENT

Fishing Lake Métis Settlement is located in the central east area of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Métis Settlements, post-secondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Fishing Lake is situated just west of the Saskatchewan border. To the north lays the Elizabeth Métis Settlement border and to the west our community borders Frog Lake First Nations. Oral history of the community tells how Métis leader Louis Riel and his supporters camped at Fishing Lake during the 1885 Métis Resistance at Batoche, Saskatchewan.

#### **OUR TOP INDUSTRIES**



#### Oil & Gas

Fishing Lake Métis Settlement is located on the Cold Lake Oil Sands deposit, the second largest oil deposit in Alberta, which produces about 160,000 barrels of oil per day. The community continues to prosper on the strength of the oil and gas industry and is always looking to foster new partnerships and ventures in order to capitalize on this growth.



#### Tourism

The Riel Beach Campsite is a major tourism attraction in Fishing Lake. Riel Beach sits on the north end of Frog Lake and offers multi-service campsites and multiple amenities such as a cookhouse, washrooms, RV electric hookups, fire pits, free firewood, playground area, and a sandy beach for boaters and fishing. On Frog Lake you will also find the Main Beach with non-powered sites and a cookhouse. The community also boasts Skate and Spray Parks for youth to enjoy.



#### Location (Land)

Fishing Lake Métis Settlement is uniquely located in a triangle corridor between the high population centre of Edmonton, the Saskatchewan border, and the resource rich areas to the north leading to Fort McMurray. Numerous lakes provide a plentiful supply of fish, the land is suitable for both mixed use agriculture and forestry. The region's abundant natural resources make the settlement a great place for investment and partnership.



#### Transportation

Fishing Lake Métis Settlement is situated within the M.D. of Bonnyville, in the heart of the heavy oil development. Fishing Lake has direct access to Hwy 897, a major north/south corridor serving the oil industry, and connecting to Hwy 28 to the north and Hwy 16 (Yellowhead Trans Canada) to the south. Fishing Lake has great market access with close proximity to the Elk Point, Bonnyville and Cold Lake airports and several transportation companies.
