Kehewin Cree Nation is located in the central eastern area of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Metis Settlements, postsecondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Kehewin Cree Nation has an economy that is based on a number of resources including oil and gas, forestry and tourism. Kehewin Cree Nation is centrally located within a regional trading center that provides excellent services to all sectors.

Oil and Gas

Kehewin Cree Nation's leading industry is the energy sector. The community is situated on the Cold Lake Oil Sands area with a production of about 160,000 barrels of oil per day (2019) and borders the Athabasca Oil Sands, which produces 1.3 million barrels of heavy oil per day. The Cold Lake Oil Sands area has Canada's largest in-situ oil sands production project accounting for approximately 5% of all crude oil produced in Canada. Major oil companies are currently producing oil in partnership with the community creating additional partnership opportunities.



Oil/Gas Servicing

Kehewin's location is perfect for upstream oil/gas service companies and has an excellent list of businesses serving this industry. This list includes prime contractors, maintenance, fluid hauling and well servicing. Kehewin Cree Nation is actively pursuing partnerhips offering a skilled and hardworking labour force with expertise in welding and metal fabrication.



Tourism

The area of Kehewin Cree Nation is full of history and breathtaking scenery. Combined with lakes and campgrounds, with Kehewin Lake in the west part of Kehewin Cree Nation and Muriel Lake in the east, this area is perfect for outdoor tourism ventures. Opportunities also exist for eco-tourism ventures coupled with aboriginal heritage teachings from Cree Nation members.



Transportation

Kehewin Cree Nation has excellent access with Highway 41, a major north/south High Load Corridor, that serves the oil industry. Highway 41 connects to Highway 28 to the north, the major east/west corridor, and south to the U.S. markets. Secondary Highway 657 heads east off Highway 41 and provides excellent access for businesses serving oil development in the northeast. Air service is available at the Bonnyville Regional Airport or the Elk Point Airport.
