ABOUT KIKINO METIS SETTLEMENT

Kikino Métis Settlement is located in the northwest of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Métis Settlements, post-secondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Kikino Métis Settlement is located 40 kilometres south of Lac La Biche on Highway 36 and our land base consists of 44,743 hectares. With a population of over 1,000, the community is situated in the middle of a vibrant agricultural and natural resource region. The primary natural resources in the area are large deposits of natural gas, extensive areas of peat, and some forested areas suitable for logging.

Oil & Gas

Due to the close proximity to three major oil fields, oil and gas is the primary industry sector pursued within the Kikino Métis Settlement. Since the 1960s, over one hundred and sixty wells have been located within Kikino and exploration and development continues today. The community is actively seeking partnership opportunities with industry and business to further pursue the opportunities available in the region.



Tourism

The topography of the Kikino Métis Settlement area is mainly characterized by old growth boreal forests and ample lakes fostering a diverse wildlife. This environment lends itself well to the development of tourism and eco-tourism ventures in the area. With regional attractions such as White Earth Valley Natural Area, Lakeland Provincial Park and numerous other sites, the area is well suited for new and expanded forays into tourism.



Forestry / Construction

The old growth boreal forests in the region provide for tremendous opportunities in sustainable forestry. Kikino Métis Settlement businesses provide a number of forestry related services including planting, harvesting and forest management. In addition, our community prides itself in our local expertise in the construction of local infrastructure projects such as new houses, businesses, roads and driveways throughout the community and the region.



Transportation

Highway 36, a High Load Corridor, runs north/south on the east side of the Settlement and connects to Hwy. 55 to the north and Highway 28 to the south. Both provide international market access. Air service is 50 km away at Lac La Biche with commercial services and air freight available via Edmonton International Airport. Rail access is available at Lac La Biche. Kikino is developing commercial/industrial land providing investment/partnership opportunities.
