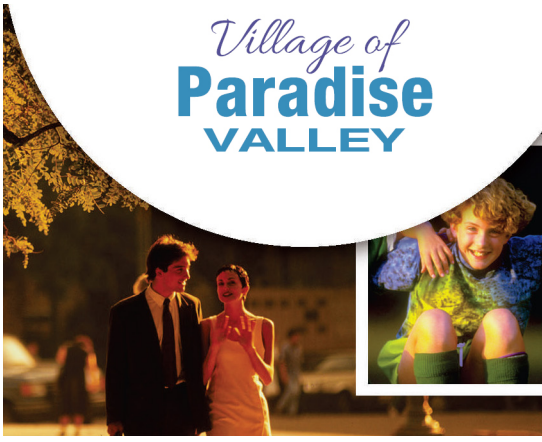

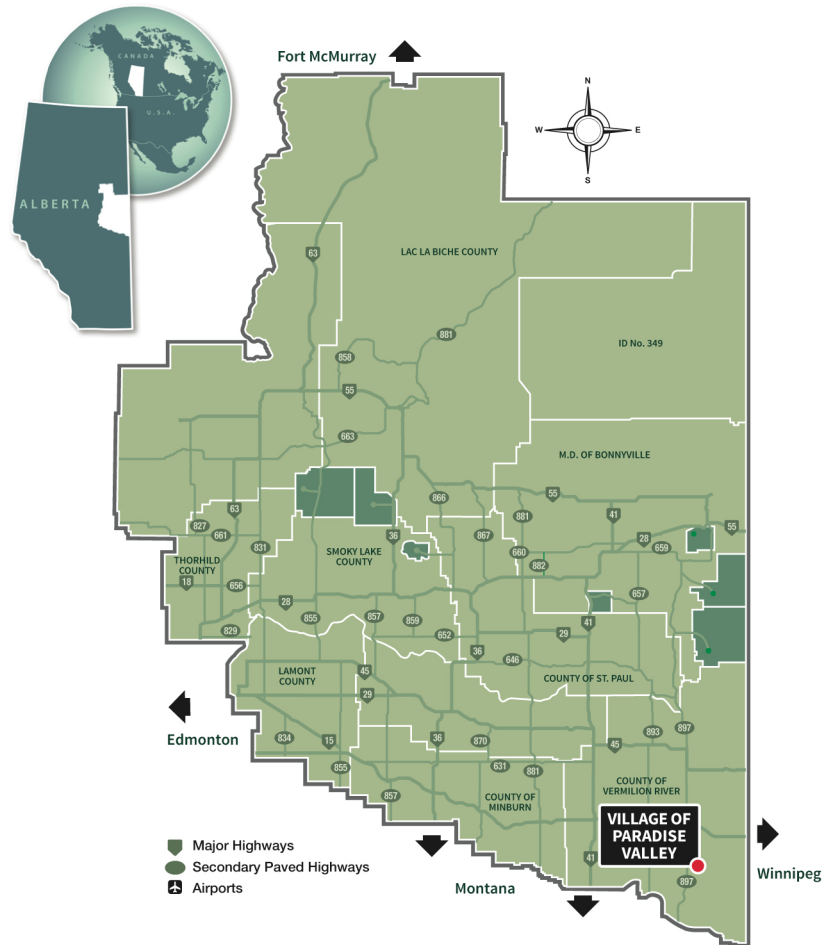


Living in Paradise Valley



ABOUT THE VILLAGE OF PARADISE VALLEY

The Village of Paradise Valley is located within the County of Vermilion River just 2 km east of Secondary Highway 897 and within driving distance to the Yellowhead (Trans Canada) Highway 16 and Highway 41, major east-west and north-south corridors in the south of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of communities, post-secondary educational institutions and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Our Village offers a quiet country atmosphere, and our residents benefit from the County of Vermilion River's many services and facilities usually only found in larger urban centers. Paradise Valley and nearby hamlets of McLaughlin and Rivercourse are referred to as the Three Cities, to maximize on our shared, local sports and recreation amenities that serve this combined area. Our many surrounding lakes, parks and unique grain elevator museum - Climb Thru Time – are tourist delights and create an enviable lifestyle for our residents.

Healthcare

The Village of Paradise Valley has access to outstanding health care facilities and programs. Residents can access services at three nearby Health Centres. The Vermilion Health Care Centre provides 24/7 emergency, and services in acute, continuing, respite, and palliative care, surgery, obstetrics, X-ray and day support. The Kitscoty Community Health Centre offers speech and language pathology, occupational therapy; physical therapy and other health services. The Wainwright Health Centre offers a range of healthcare services including a laboratory and 24/7 emergency.



Education

The Village of Paradise Valley is part of the Buffalo Trails School Division and also part of the East Central Alberta Catholic School Division, both headquartered in the Town of Wainwright. The Village has one public school, E.H. Walter School, which serves students from Kindergarten to Grade 12. Lakeland College in the Town of Vermilion offers many academic programs and a range of vocational programs. An expanding curriculum in adult education, literacy tutoring and academic upgrading is also offered.



Housing

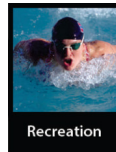

Community Services

Our Village offers recreation, sports, and government services to its residents, as well as places of worship. In addition, our excellent emergency services include:

- The RCMP protective services for the Village are provided through the Town of Vermilion, the Village of Kitscoty and the City of Lloydminster.
- The committed members of the Paradise Valley volunteer fire department is able to respond to incidents twenty-four hours a day from their homes or work. Neighbouring communities also offer volunteer fire support.
- The County is part of the 911 system with the Prairie Emergency Medical Services providing reliable 24-hr ambulance services.



Recreation

Our Village offers families the opportunity to stay active and healthy through our many sports and recreation opportunities including the Three Cities Arena, Regional Park and Fair. Through the County of Vermilion River, residents have a wide range of recreational facilities including curling rinks, ice arenas, dance halls, gymnasiums, ball diamonds, campgrounds, and playgrounds. Our picturesque countryside also provides for many outdoor activities. Hunting, snowmobiling, cross-country skiing, water sports, golfing, fishing and much more can be experienced in the area.
