Hugging the shores of Alberta's 5th largest lake, Cold Lake is one of the fastest growing urban centers in Alberta. Cold Lake's economy has contributed to it being named the 5th best place to live in Alberta and the 35th in Canada (Money Sense Magazine). Boasting 4 Wing, Canada's largest air defence base, major oil and gas industry players, and the proximity to Saskatchewan customers, Cold Lake has reason to be excited about the future. OUR TOP INDUSTRIES



Oil and Gas

Cold Lake continues to grow on the strength of our oil and gas industries. Cold Lake operations produce about 160,000 barrels of oil per day with an additional 55,000 to come from the Cold Lake expansion project. Imperial Oil Limited's Cold Lake production project is Canada's largest in-situ oil sands operation producing approximately 5% of all crude oil produced in Canada.



Air Force and Aerospace

The City has a solid foundation for the aerospace industry and is working to expand opportunities for companies to utilize the valuable investment we have in people and infrastructure. The 4 Wing Cold Lake fighter base, the busiest and largest air fighter base, provides the world's largest low fly zone and controlled airspace; ideal for the testing of Unmanned Air Vehicle systems.



Retail and Hospitality

The bustling City supports over 650 licensed businesses, with an active Regional Chamber of Commerce, a vibrant downtown business hub and a scenic lakeshore business district. The City is the retail hub of the region with a local trading area of 30,000 people and a greater trading area of approximately 50,000. The Tri-City Mall and the multitude of retail businesses, restaurants and entertainment opportunities draw shoppers from all over Northeast Alberta and Saskatchewan.



Transportation

Access to Cold Lake is gained through Alberta Provincial Highway 28, northeast of Edmonton, and the Northern Woods and Water Route Highway 55. Red Arrow Connector offers a regularly scheduled passenger service from Cold Lake to Edmonton. The Cold Lake Regional Airport, 4 kms west of Cold Lake and the civilian air terminal at CFB Cold Lake the Medley terminal - are being looked at for expanded air services.
