


Living in The City of Lloydminster

Lloydminster is located in the northeast corner of the Alberta HUB region. Healthcare

Operated by the Saskatchewan Health Authority, Lloydminster healthcare facilities are served by the Prairie North Health Region. There are many health centres in Lloydminster and the surrounding area. Lloydminster Hospital provides a range of healthcare services including 24/7 emergency department and The Lloydminster Community Cancer Centre. Other services:

Education

Lloydminster offers residents a range of public schooling, Catholic education, post-secondary education and training opportunities. The Lloydminster Public School Division is home to 10 elementary, middle and high schools and features specialized programs such as Early Learning Programs, Education Support Services and Specialized Support Services. The Lloydminster Catholic School Division has six schools. The 2016 Census states 13,325 people in Lloydminster have a postsecondary certificate, diploma or degree and 3,035 have apprenticeship or trades certificates. Lakeland College and Reeves Business College have campuses in Lloydminster. Lakeland College's enrollment is over 2,400 students in Lloydminster offering an array of programs from Business to Trades & Technology to Agricultural Sciences.



Housing

Approximately 32,000 people call Lloydminster home and the city was recently ranked among one of the fastest-growing communities in Canada. Quality, affordable family living is available throughout Lloydminster. Residential subdivisions of all sizes are underway with many serviced lots available for new construction.

Community Services

Lloydminster is service centre for the region. We have a full complement of healthcare and wellness services, emergency services, and a thriving retail sector.

- The City's Social Programs and Services Department works to connect people to resources. Social Program and Services Department's funding mostly comes from Family and Community Support Services (FCSS).
- Fire Services staffs a team of four full-time positions: Fire Chief, two Deputy Fire Chiefs, a Training/Safety Officer, and an operational volunteer force of 40 members that proudly protect the community.
- The City of Lloydminster contracts the RCMP to provide municipal police services.



Recreation

The City of Lloydminster is a vibrant community with inclusivity at the heart of our identity. We're proud of our recreation and culture facilities and are committed to ensuring residents and visitors can access our facilities and enjoy a welcoming, positive experience.
