


Living in The Town of Bonnyville



ABOUT THE TOWN OF BONNYVILLE

The Town of Bonnyville is located in the center of the Alberta HUB region. The Alberta HUB is a partnership of communities, post-secondary educational institutions and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. The Town of Bonnyville is a strong and vibrant community of 6,422 (2017 census) with parks and recreational amenities that rival urban centers. The economy is based on a number of industries including heavy oil and gas, agriculture, forestry and natural resources such as fishing, wildlife and other forms of tourism. Bonnyville is a regional trading center that provides services to all sectors. Situated on Jessie Lake, a natural wetlands and home to 200 bird species, Bonnyville is a great place to work, play and raise a family. It provides the perfect mix of community services through health, educational, recreation and cultural facilities.

Healthcare

Bonnyville's healthcare needs are served by the Bonnyville Health Centre, which has 24 acute care beds, 30 long term care beds and 10 day beds. The Northeastern Alberta Health Unit has an office in Bonnyville and offers public health, dental health, health inspector, home care, speech and language pathology, and diabetic clinic services. Other facilities available in Bonnyville include medical and dental clinics, optometrist, and chiropractors. Bonnyville also has the Bonnylodge, a 42room senior citizen lodge, and Extendicare Bonnyville.



Community Services

Bonnyville features an excellent variety of local organizations, stores, specialty shops, restaurants, motels and service businesses that provide unique products and personalized service. We are very proud of our vibrant main street, specialized businesses, and emergency services:

- The Bonnyville Regional Fire Authority provides fire protection, 911 and dispatch services, as well as emergency medical services to many areas in Northeast Alberta.
- The Town of Bonnyville has a local RCMP detachment.
- Bonnyville Municipal Ambulance Service provides Advanced Basic Life Support service.



Education

Bonnyville features diverse educational options:

- Northern Lights Public School System: Wide list of schools including a Tech Prep Value-Added Diploma to gualify students for technical training institutions.
- Roman Catholic Separate School System: Lakeland Catholic Separate School District.
- Francophone Education: East Central Francophone Education Region No. 3 and the Ecole des Beaux-Lacs School.

Recreation

Bonnyville offers a variety of recreational and leisure opportunities for people of all ages. Bonnyville is the only town in the northeast that has a Junior "A" Hockey Team. The Bonnyville Golf and Country Club includes 18 scenic holes, practice range, pro shop, restaurant and lounge. We have an indoor swimming pool, the R.J. Lalonde Arena (Centennial Centre), bowling alley, curling club, cultural centre with a theatre and stage, a new public library, a district historical museum, numerous playgrounds and parks, a skateboard park, and a Parent Child Centre that houses the Day Care, pre-school programs, and a family resource centre.
