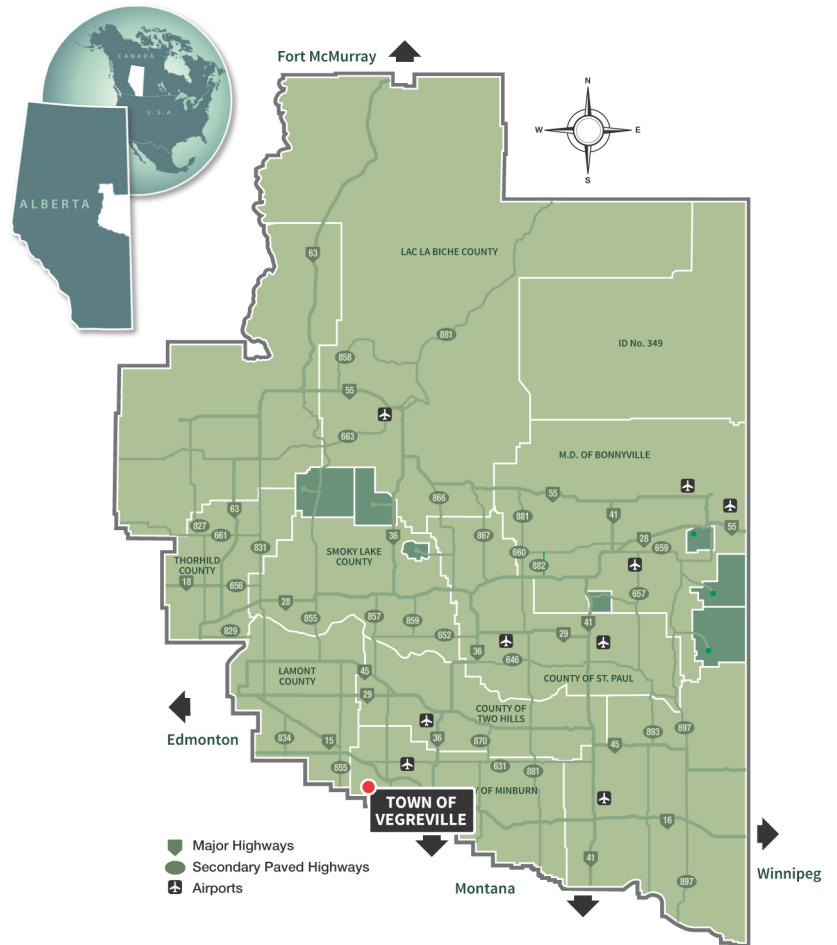


ABOUT THE TOWN OF VEGREVILLE

Healthcare

Healthcare is an extremely large part of what makes Vegreville a great place for your family. Vegreville currently has several competent family physicians who are always accepting new patients. These physicians work out of three different locations, **St. Joseph's General Hospital**, **Vegreville Family Clinic**, and the **Kalyna Country Primary Care Network**. The family clinic has weekly walk-in hours for any minor ailment or illness making it easy to get yourself or a loved one treatment quickly. St. Joseph's General Hospital, a Covenant Health facility, is equipped with an Emergency Room, onsite Lab and X-Ray, and a 24-bed acute care floor.



Education

Vegreville is a community with great education opportunities for people of any age and any skill set. With a local preschool, two elementary and secondary school systems, distance learning, and connections to surrounding colleges - quality education is extremely accessible to anyone in our community. The Vegreville Preschool Association offers a tailored version of Alberta Education's Kindergarten Curriculum. Through a "Learn through Play" approach, children are prepared for Kindergarten and are given the ability to be outstanding members of our community.

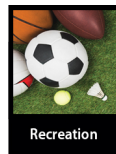


Community Services

Vegreville is an excellent place to live with reasonable housing/rental prices, top-class educational, medical, recreational, and cultural facilities, and a wide range of retail services.

- Vegreville Emergency Services consists of the Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services: Vegreville is served by a 30 plus member NFPA 1001 trained volunteer fire department with training in hazardous materials incident and technical rescue
- The Town is served by a RCMP detachment
- Ambulance Services: Vegreville Emergency Services

We recognize the importance of reducing our carbon footprint. In the last three years, the Vegreville Materials Recovery Facility (VMRF) has shipped the equivalent of 93 tractor-trailer loads of recyclable materials to processing facilities. If these tractor-trailer loads were lined up they would stretch a total of 1.25 km or 14 football fields.
