OUR TOP INDUSTRIES



Oil and Gas

Heavy oil development makes Vermilion strategically located. Vermilion is located on the southern end of the Cold Lake Oil Sands area with access via Highway 41, a major north/south corridor. With production over 500,000 barrels/day, Vermilion is perfect for serving the Oil/Gas industry. Access to global markets is gained utilizing CN rail, which runs east/west through Vermilion.



Agriculture

Agriculture is the primary regional industry with sales of grains, oil seeds, beef cattle, hogs and dairy products. Vermilion is a strong and effective service centre supported by grain elevators, machinery agents, farm supply distributors, veterinary and government services. Agland, Rocky Mountain Equipment, Ireland Farm Equipment, Webb's Machinery, Nutrien, Richardson Pioneer, G3, Seed Cleaning Plant, North Central Livestock are just a few key Agricultural establishments servicing Vermilion. Lakeland College powered by New Holland provides labour and research to our Ag sector. Investment and development opportunities for value-added agricultural are endless.



Land - Location

Vermilion is located in the Agriculture and Oil/Gas hub of northeastern Alberta. To accommodate this growth, three business parks have been developed: a Highway Commercial Business Park – Junction Sixteen 41 with access to Hwy 41 and two Industrial Business Parks – East Point Business Park with access to air and Yellowhead Business Park with access to Hwy 41 and twinned Hwy 16. Millions of dollars of freight travel north and south through Vermilion servicing the Ag and Oil/Gas sectors to the Alberta Oil Sands and the U.S. markets.



Transportation

Vermilion is located at the junction of the Yellowhead Trans Canada at Hwy 16 and Hwy 41. The Vermilion Airport is a paved, lighted, year round facility with a 3,300 foot runway. Vermilion is a terminal point for CN rail connecting to the Asian markets at the Port of Vancouver and the eastern seaboard. Spur tracks and CN lease land are available for industrial and commercial entities.
