



Healthcare

The Town of Vermilion has outstanding health care facilities and programs. The Vermilion Health Care Centre provides services in emergency, acute, continuing, respite, and palliative care, surgery, obstetrics, X-ray and day support. The emergency room is accessible 24 hours a day. Visiting hours are from 11am to 8pm with some exceptions. There is a cafeteria in the building that is open to the public.



Community Services

Vermilion has a Community Services Department that enhances the quality of life of town residents by facilitating community partnerships that contribute to an economically strong, socially connected, culturally vibrant, and a sustainable community. Emergency services include: RCMP includes the community-based police force and highway patrol. The volunteer fire department has state of the art equipment. The Town of Vermilion is part of the 911 system with the Prairie Emergency Medical Services providing reliable 24-hr ambulance services.



Education

Vermilion is home to an abundance of education opportunities. Public Schools – Vermilion Elementary School (VES)(Grades K-6), J.R. Robson School (Grades 7-12), and Vermilion Outreach School (Grades 10-12); Separate Schools – St. Jerome's School (Grades K-12); Home Schooling – School of Hope – Vermilion Home Schooling (Grades 1-12); and Post-Secondary Education through Lakeland College (www.lakelandcollege.ca)! Other Educational Programs also exist within the Town of Vermilion including CLASS Vermilion River Adult Learning, Vermilion and Area Brighter Beginnings, and Vermilion Play Development Early Learning Center just to name a few.
