Andrew is located in the west of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Metis Settlements, post-secondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Home of the world's largest mallard duck, Andrew is located in the northeast of Lamont County on Secondary Highway 855, just south of Highway 45. Andrew is also three kilometres northwest of Whitford Lake, which is a major flyway for waterfowl, a must see for bird watchers. While you are in Andrew, visit the Andrew Museum and climb aboard the caboose car. If you would like to "putter around" a little, stop by the Andrew mini-golf for an enjoyable round of mini golf.

OUR TOP INDUSTRIES

Oil and Gas

Andrew is in proximity to Edmonton, the sixth largest metropolitan area of Canada, and to the South Athabasca Oil Sands area, which has a projected production of over 3.4 million barrels of oil per day. Drilling, seismic, and pipeline construction contribute significantly to the local economy. Numerous opportunities exist for upstream oil service companies to locate to Andrew and benefit from the support services the village provides.

Agriculture

Agriculture is an integral industry sector and coincides with the country lifestyle in Andrew and the region. Andrew is located in Lamont County with 2021 gross farm receipts of \$149 million. Multiple livestock and poultry operations in the region also produce a variety of different crops such as alfalfa, canola, barley, oats, wheat and hay.



Location

The Village of Andrew is uniquely located in a triangle corridor between the high population center of Edmonton, the Saskatchewan border, and the resource rich areas to the north leading to the Alberta Oil Sands. The land in our region of the province is suitable for both mixed use agriculture and forestry, numerous regional lakes provide recreation, and the region's abundant natural resources make Andrew a great place for investment and partnership.



Transportation

Andrew is located at the junction of Hwy. 45 and Secondary Hwy. 855, which connects to Hwy. 16 (the Yellowhead Trans Canada) and north to Hwy. 28, the major east/west corridor servicing the Oil Sands in northeastern Alberta. 855 north is direct access to the northern Alberta Oil Sands development. Hwy. 45 is an east/west corridor to Alberta's Industrial Heartland in the west and northeastern Alberta's oil development. Commercial and air freight services are located at Edmonton International Airport.
