


Living in The Village of Andrew



ABOUT THE VILLAGE OF ANDREW

The Village of Andrew is located in the west of the Alberta HUB region, and close to the eastern edge of the Alberta Industrial Heartland. The Alberta HUB is a partnership of communities, post-secondary educational institutions and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to promote the quality of life and economic opportunities of the region. If a friendly and affordable community appeals to you, come to Andrew. Located in the northeast corner of Lamont County, you will be greeted to our Village by the world's largest Mallard. Erected in 1992, the duck has a 25 foot wing span and weighs 5,000 pounds. It is posed in flight symbolizing the migration path over Andrew to Whitford Lake, a bird Sanctuary. Andrew residents enjoy a quiet and safe country setting with many amenities available to them. We are a busy community with local events all the time. Our claim to fame is Ed Stelmach Avenue - our tribute to former Premier Ed Stelmach, Alberta's 13th Premier and one of our very own.

Healthcare

Andrew is nearly equidistant from three area hospitals -Lamont, one of the top ranked small hospitals in Canada, and Two Hills and Vegreville, which offer more extensive diagnostic and treatment options. Other health care amenities in Andrew include:

- Seniors' continuing care facility,
- Weekly doctor's office visits,
- Lab collections every second Friday morning,
- Urban Escape massage therapy.



Education

Andrew School is part of the Elk Island School Division #14. The School provides education K-12 and has maintained high standards, producing marks above the provincial average. Andrew School has a active Parent-School Council. Volunteers run the canteen and noon-hour supervision. For postsecondary education, Portage College Campus - Saddle Lake is close by, as are a number of options in Edmonton.



Housing

Andrew boasts modern commercial and residential areas with all amenities, and moderate pricing has attracted several new families. Local realtors include:

Community Services

The Village of Andrew features many amenities: Edmonton water, garbage pickup, recycling program, Family and Community Support Services, Seniors Rainbow Drop-in Centre, community centre, grocery stores, and several restaurants. Emergency services include:

- Fire protection: Andrew is served by the Andrew Volunteer Fire Department [911]
- Police Services: Andrew is served by the Two Hills RCMP detachment - Andrew satellite office
- Ambulance Services: Lakeland Ambulance has a base in Andrew



Recreation

There is a lot to do in the Village of Andrew and the surrounding area. Local facilities include a Recreation/Fitness Centre (bowling alley, sauna, hot tub, fitness room with equipment), tennis court, arena (hockey, figure skating, curling), playgrounds, bingo and a public library. The Village Duck Stop and Recreational Services include a multi-purpose room, bowling, and an exercise room. We also have an RV park, baseball diamonds and a skateboard park. Andrew is close to Elk Island National Park, and golf facilities both there and at Mundare.
