


Living in The Village of Boyle

Healthcare

There are a range of healthcare services in the Village of Boyle. The Boyle Health Care Centre provides emergency room care, lab and x-ray, addictions and mental health, and other general and specialized health services, and the Silver Birch Medical Centre has family physicians. There are chiropractic and dental services within the Village and other health-related professional services can be accessed nearby for optometry, massage, physiotherapy, and much more!



Community Services

In the Village of Boyle, emergency services include by-law enforcement, RCMP and fire protection services from a volunteer fire department. Call 911 in an emergency and the Call Answer Service will identify your physical location and connect you to Fire, Ambulance or Police Services. STARS has a fuel cache at the Athabasca Regional Airport and provides emergency transport. There are several volunteer and service groups to meet your community service needs.



Education

The Aspen View School Division has one school within the Village (K-12) and there are additional daycare and preschool programs available. Post Secondary education and training can be achieved within Athabasca County through Northern Lakes College, Portage College and Athabasca University. The Village of Boyle is home to Portage College's innovative Heavy Equipment Operator and Pipeline Training campus that provides both simulated and practical experience for those looking for work in oil and gas, construction, or road building industries.



Recreation

The Village is uniquely situated close to the Alberta Boreal forest's lower edge with two lakes within a 10 min drive make the area an outdoor enthusiasts' delight. The Millview Recreation Complex offers ice sports opportunities or enjoy the other recreational facilities: ball diamonds, spray park, four parks, fitness centre, community centre and various courts including tennis, pickleball and basketball. Take in Boyle's Centennial Historic Walking Trails, or the local Rodeo or Annual Wildberry Festival.



The Village of Boyle provides housing choices to meet the diverse needs of its community. These include single family homes, country residential acreages, apartments and condominiums, and farm properties. Cost of living (monthly shelter costs) is roughly 14% below Alberta costs & median house prices were roughly 12% below Alberta prices. The Village also has senior living options for its aging residents.
