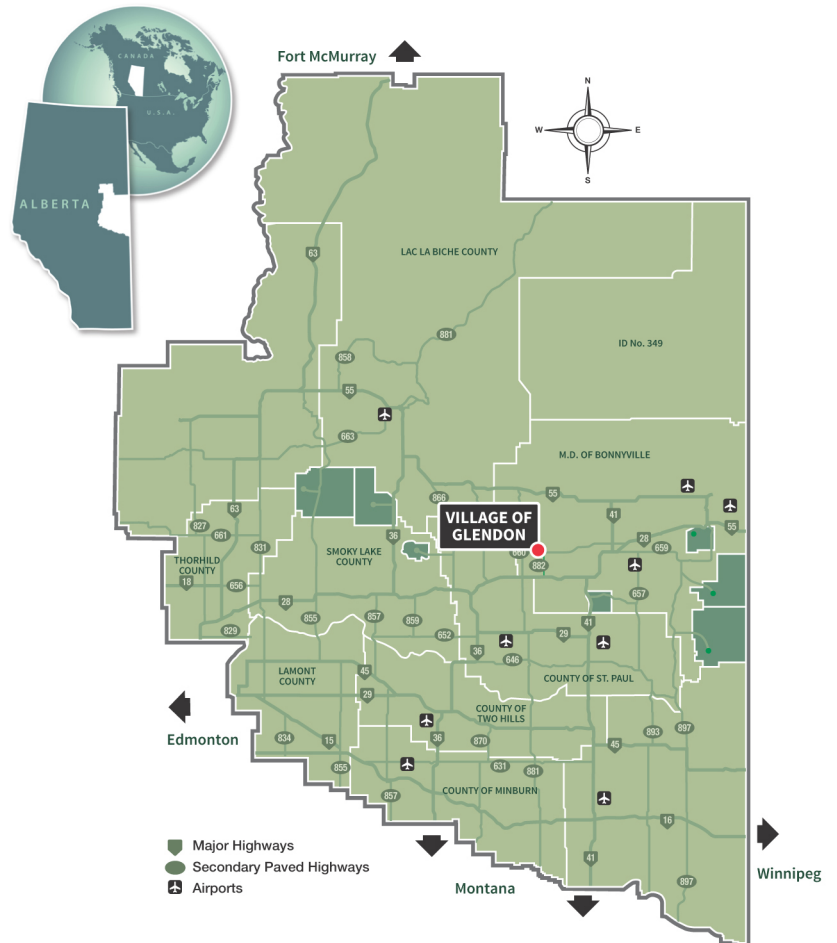

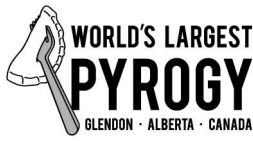
ABOUT THE VILLAGE OF GLENDON

Healthcare

Glendon offers clinical and laboratory services at the Glendon Community Health Services site. A local physician, Dr. Vincent Mannion, works out of this site and also operates his own private clinic, Glendon Medical Services. Village resident's hospital needs are served by the nearby Town of Bonnyville Health Centre, which has acute care, long term care, and day beds. The northeastern Alberta Health Unit has an office in Bonnyville and offers public health, dental health, health inspector, home care, speech and language pathology, and diabetic clinic services.



Education

Glendon School (K-12), part of Northern Lights School Division, takes pride in their hard work and continually undertakes professional development to improve and gain new knowledge. It is a thoroughly modern school with advanced technology and students have access to all of the necessary tools to be successful. Glendon School has full computer labs, classroom computers, video conferencing suites and other resources make learning a state-of-the-art experience. Post-secondary educational options are close by at Portage College in Bonnyville and Lakeland College in the new C.N.R.L Learning Centre.



Housing

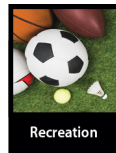

Community Services

Glendon has all the basic services including a grocery store, convenience store, coin laundry, tire shop, car wash, post office, hardware store, Sears outlet, transport depot, restaurants, a bulk fuel station, liquor store, drug store, senior citizen's home, hockey arena with large dine and dance hall, curling rink and lounge, hunting and fishing supply store, etc. Policing is provided by the nearby Bonnyville RCMP detachment; the M.D. of Bonnyville Public Safety provides by-law enforcement and traffic control; Bonnyville Regional Fire Authority provides fire protection; and there are 911 and Dispatch Services as well as Emergency Medical Services.



Recreation

Glendon invites you to participate in the many activities available here or just come out to relax in our cozy little village. We are surrounded by many recreational and fishing lakes, such as Minnie Lake, Moose Lake, Muriel Lake, Seibert Lake (trophy), Pinehurst Lake, and Spencer Lake. Tourists travel to see our Pyrogy and to access the Lakeland Provincial Park. The Pyrogy Park is equipped with a play area for children and the giant 25 foot pyrogy! Thousands of visitors attend the largest truck demolition derby in Alberta, Glendon's Derby Daze in August. For the campers, the Village of Glendon offers fresh water and a RV dumping station.
