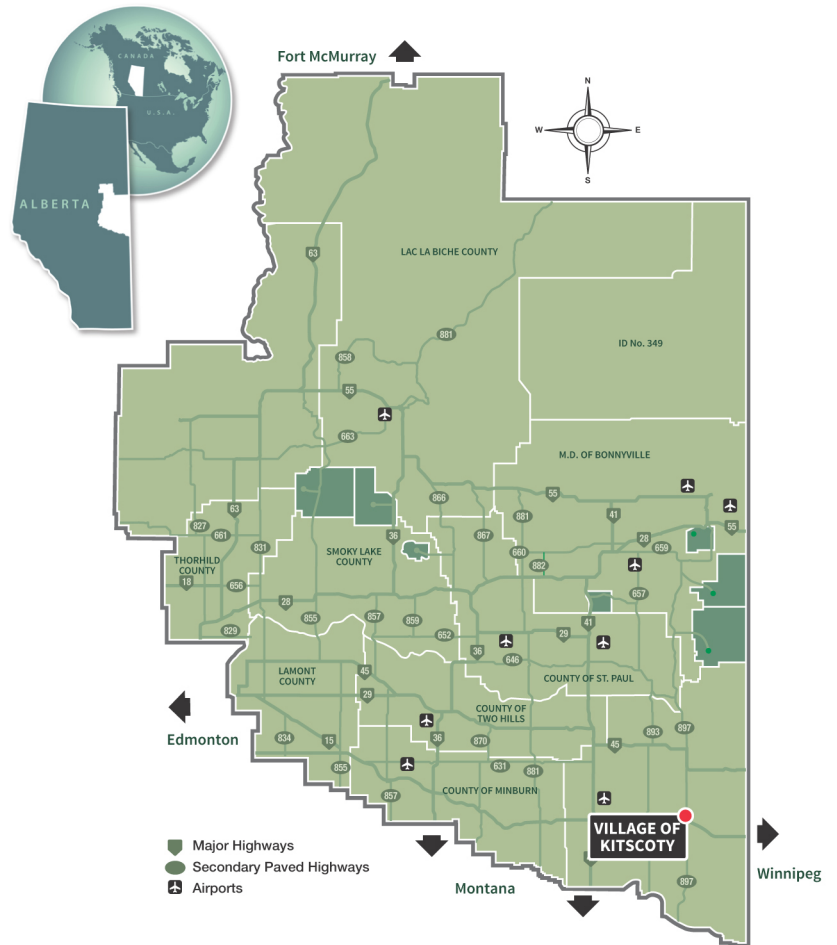


Living in The Village of Kitscoty

Healthcare

The Lloydminster Hospital, Saskatchewan's Prairie North Regional Health Authority, provides health services to Alberta residents of the Saskatchewan border city of Lloydminster and is a contracted service provider facility. The Hospital provides acute care, emergency, rehabilitation, obstetrics, and more. Its visiting hours are 11:00 am - 9:00 pm and it provides 24-Hour Emergency Services. The Vermilion Health Centre is also within a half an hour drive and offers services in acute and continuing care, emergency, palliative care, diagnostic and therapeutic services, and more.



Education

Kitscoty is truly blessed with an excellent support and teaching staff and facilities that make a parent appreciate small town living with big city amenities. Kitscoty is located within the Buffalo Trail Public School Division #28, headquartered in Wainwright. Schools in Kitscoty include Kitscoty Elementary School (K-6) and Kitscoty Jr/Sr High School. Post-secondary educational opportunities are at Lakeland College, which is within commuting distance from Kitscoty in both Lloydminster and Vermilion. In addition, the Hilltop Library has after school and summer hours for the public.

The Village of Kitscoty has affordable housing and is a community full of recreational variety and opportunity. Nearby realtors are ready to assist you:

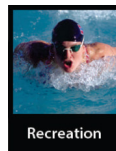

Community Services

Visitors to Kitscoty will enjoy a variety of commercial services including a fully modern hotel, family restaurants, groceries, gas, antiques, beauty salon, post office, banking agency, insurance, ATM, and more. Emergency 911 services include:

- Fire - Kitscoty is well served by a local volunteer fire department and trained first responders.
- Police Services - Kitscoty is very fortunate to have a RCMP detachment situated in and serving the Village.
- Ambulance Services - The Lloydminster and District Ambulance provides service to Kitscoty.
- Kitscoty is a member of the East Central 9-11 Society, which provides Fire Dispatch.



Recreation

Kitscoty has outstanding recreational opportunities including the Kitscoty and District Regional Park, with 19 powered sites. The nine-hole golf course offers a convenient and relaxed round of golf, where you can try your hand at putting on sand greens! The two shale ball diamonds often feature minor ball games or tournaments. There are several walking trails and parks to enjoy. In the winter, our arena and curling rink bustle with league and tournament activity.
