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OUR TOP INDUSTRIES



Heavy crude oil exploration development has found Mannville to be strategically located. The oil fields in Eastern Alberta and the Alberta Oil Sands area to the north are easily accessible from Mannville along Highway 16, Secondary Highway 881 or nearby Highway 41, a High Load Corridor leading to major oil and gas developments. Opportunities exist for commercial and industrial properties for new business development and growth.

Agriculture

Agriculture is a primary industry as Mannville is located in the heart of one of the largest counties in the Alberta HUB region, Minburn County. With over \$281 million in Gross Farm Receipts (2021), the region is a strong and effective service center with major grain terminals, machinery agents, farm supply distributors, veterinary and government services. Global markets for grains and livestock are reached with major Highways 16, 36 and 41.




Location - Land

Mannville has a good selection of reasonably priced residential properties available along industrial highway commercial parcels adjacent to Highway 16 and Secondary Highway 881 to service the major industries in the area. Land costs are lower thus resulting in a higher return on investments. Excellent access to national and international markets exist in Mannville.



Transportation

Two major corridors intersect at Mannville, Highway 16 connects west to the Edmonton International Airport and on to Port Vancouver and east to international logistic hubs in Eastern Canada. Secondary Hwy 881 north is a main corridor to the Alberta Oil Sands. Hwy 36 located just west of Mannville is a direct connection to the U.S. market. Excellent air service is offered at the Vermilion Airport just 30 minutes away. Mannville is also served by the CN Rail line with access opportunities.
