#### ABOUT THE TOWN OF BRUDERHEIM

The Town of Bruderheim is located in the southwest of the Alberta HUB region within the Alberta Industrial Heartland. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Metis Settlements, post-secondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Located a short 30 minute drive east of Edmonton on Highway 15, the Town of Bruderheim is in an enviable position with access to two railroads. This progressive community of 1,395 residents provides relaxed country living with all the amenities of a larger center. Bruderheim has a range of services including accommodations, fine dining, and access to shopping that make this an ideal place to start a business and family.

#### **OUR TOP INDUSTRIES**



#### Oil and Gas

Located in resource-rich Lamont County,
Bruderheim is in the Alberta Industrial Heartland
where investment currently exceeds \$40 billion. It is
also part of the Alberta HUB region, which has a
history of successful oil sands development. There
are over 1700 oil/gas wells in the County and the
Town is ideally located to service regional oil sands
projects. Many opportunities exist to establish a
business base in Bruderheim.



#### Service Industry (Oil, Gas and Petrochemical)

Located close to the skilled Greater Edmonton Area work force and within the Alberta Industrial Heartland, Bruderheim is ideally located for oil, gas and petrochemical industry transportation and services. Both major Canadian railways run through and intersect nearby. The area is well served by major highways, including a High Load Corridor. Major pipelines run nearby, enhancing Bruderheim's appeal to the service industry.



#### Agriculture

Agriculture is a major industry for Bruderheim and Lamont County, the third largest county in the Alberta HUB region, with gross farm receipts of \$149 million (2021). There are multiple livestock operations in the region and farms that produce a variety of crops including canola, barley, wheat and peas. Bruderheim is a hub for the hemp industry - the Canadian Rockies Hemp Corporation's recently commissioned processing lines offer hemp processing and purchase orders to the region. #### **Transportation**

Highways 16 (Yellowhead), 15 and 29 are all close to the town, providing excellent routes to various destinations, including Edmonton, which is 50 km southwest of Bruderheim. Hwy 15, a High Load Corridor, runs right past Bruderheim, making the town a perfect logistics center. The Town has access to both CN and CP rail lines and takes advantage of two nearby airports: Edmonton International and the Josephburg Airport.
