


Living in Town of Redwater



The Town of Redwater is a vibrant, welcoming community, home to approximately 2,200 people and 120+ businesses. Residents enjoy the healthy, relaxed lifestyle of their picturesque rural surroundings with the added bonus of easy access to urban amenities. The Town is located 35 minutes North East of Edmonton and Fort Saskatchewan and only minutes from Alberta's Industrial Heartland.

The Town of Redwater is a self-sufficient, family orientated community that continues to grow, with its residents enjoying local amenities, including K-12 schools with Registered Apprenticeship Programs, quality emergency & medical services, RCMP detachment, a first class recreational and cultural facility, a 9-hole golf course, curling club, outdoor swimming pool, as well as numerous parks & sporting venues. Perfect for nature hikes and bird watching with over 100 km of trails for equestrian and recreational use.

Healthcare

The Redwater Health Centre is a 21-bed accredited facility. The Centre (acute care, emergency, and continuing care) employs over 100 staff in Administration, Emergency/Acute Care Nursing/Continuing Care, Lab/X-ray, Health Records, Pharmacy, Admitting, Social Work, Education, Environmental Services, Stores, Nutrition and Food Services, Maintenance, and Rehabilitation Services (Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Respiratory therapy, and Speech Language Pathology).

The facility provides 24-hour emergency and ambulance services. Community Health and Home Care services are also located within the Redwater Health Centre.



Community Services

Redwater is a safe and secure community with a RCMP detachment, Volunteer Fire Department and Bylaw enforcement serving the Town of Redwater. Other services include Family and Community Support Services, volunteer groups and parks maintenance. Curbside Garbage, Organics and recycling pick-up are provided for all residential properties.



Education

The Town of Redwater has two public schools, part of the Sturgeon School Division. Ochre Park School serves students from K to grade 4 and Redwater School serves students from grade 5 to 9. Sturgeon Adult Learning provides educational opportunities for adults.



Recreation

Redwater has a variety of recreation options to stay healthy including an outdoor rink/skateboard and ball hockey facility, parks and sports pitches, minor sports groups, curling, golfing, and walking trails. The town also has a campground, museum and library. The Redwater Provincial Recreation Area boasts one of the largest sand dune fields in the region.



Housing

Redwater is comprised of a mix of affordable residential housing options; single family dwellings, and multi-residential dwellings.
